WRECK NAVIGATION HAZARD - 16M FIBERGLASS CRUISER

DATE: Thursday 23rd January 2025

PREVIOUS NOTICE: Vic NtoM No.047(T) of 2025 is referred and cancelled.

DETAILS: Mariners are advised that the burnt wreck of the 16m (53') Activa Fiberglass Cruiser (RV418 "Not Too Bad") is securely grounded approximately 800m East of the Port Welshpool Fishermans Jetty in position;
Lat 38° 42.129' South
Lon. 146° 28.507' East Datum WGS84

There is a small amount of diesel leaking from the wreck which has been surrounded by absorbent boom.

The wreck has been marked with a lit Isolated Danger Buoy (Fl.(2).4s)

Insurance assessors and salvors are expected to inspect the wreck today to establish a course of action for salvage to shore.

Mariners are advised to take extra precaution when navigating Lewis Channel in the vicinity of the wreck, especially at night.
