Pursuant to *Section 70(1)(d)* of the *Marine and Coastal Act 2018*, and as delegated by the Minister, I consent to the proposed use and development subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Conditions:
 - a. The works are to be carried out in accordance with the information provided in application form and supporting details and plans, received on 30 November 2023.
 - b. Any modification to the proposed works will require further written approval by the Regional Director, Gippsland, Department of Energy, Environment and Climate Action (DEECA).
 - c. Construction equipment, building materials, refuse and site run-off must be contained and controlled and not permitted to impact on the foreshore or enter the waterway.
 - d. Any associated access points and/or work sites that are established, are to be maintained to a safe standard to avoid public risk and access restricted with the use of appropriate signage and barriers, as required.
 - e. Works must cease immediately upon the discovery of any Aboriginal cultural material and Aboriginal Victoria be immediately notified of any such discovery.
 - f. All works must be completed and maintained to the satisfaction of the Regional Director, Gippsland, DEECA.
 - g. The floating pontoon jetty and boat ramp is required to be licensed, under s140A *Land Act 1958*, issued by DEECA.
 - h. This consent under the *Marine and Coastal Act 2018* will expire if the works are not completed within three (3) years of the date of issue, unless an extension of time is applied for in writing and granted by the Regional Director, Gippsland, DEECA.
